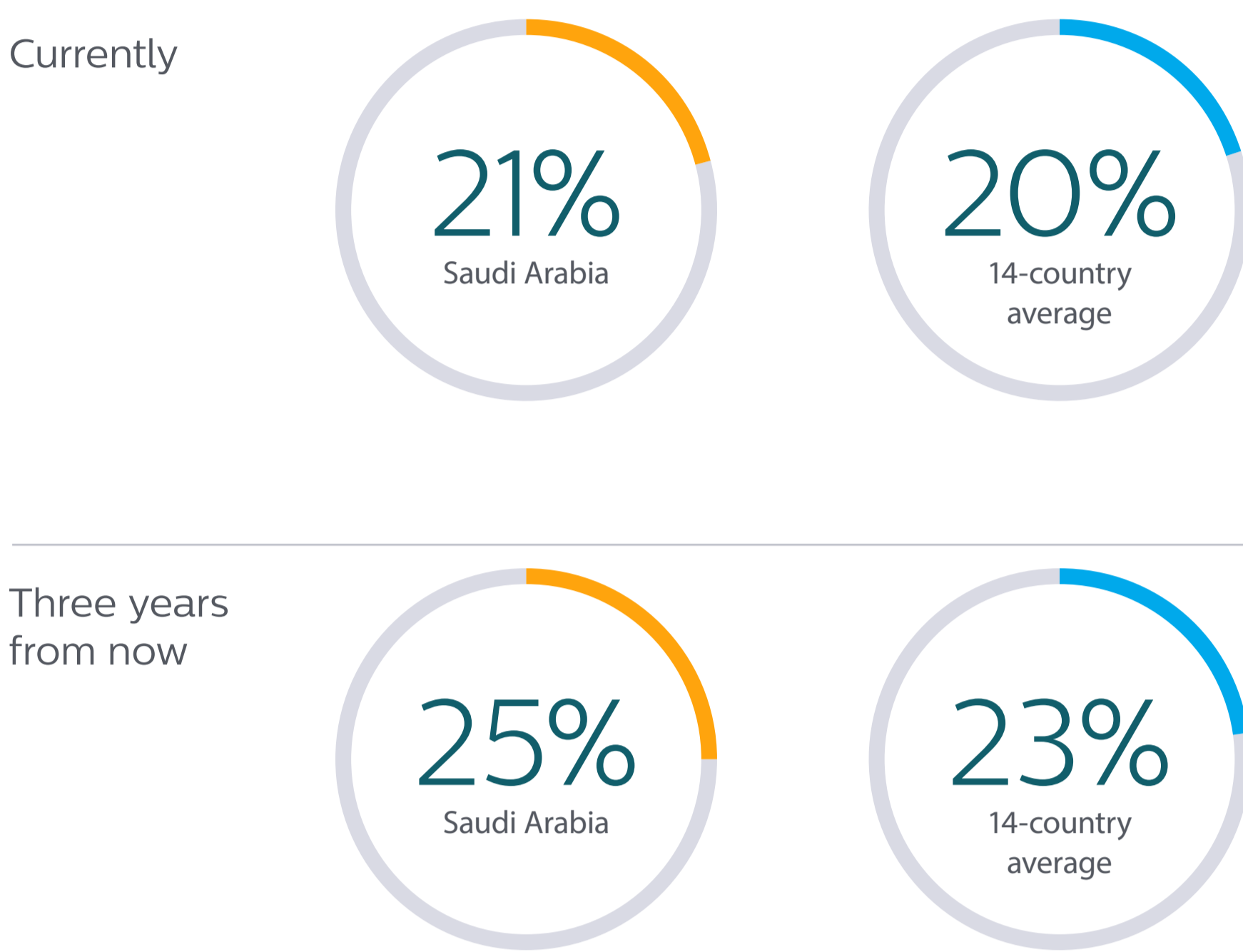
The Future Health Index 2021 Saudi Arabia report is based on primary research exploring how healthcare leaders are meeting the demands and building a resilient future.



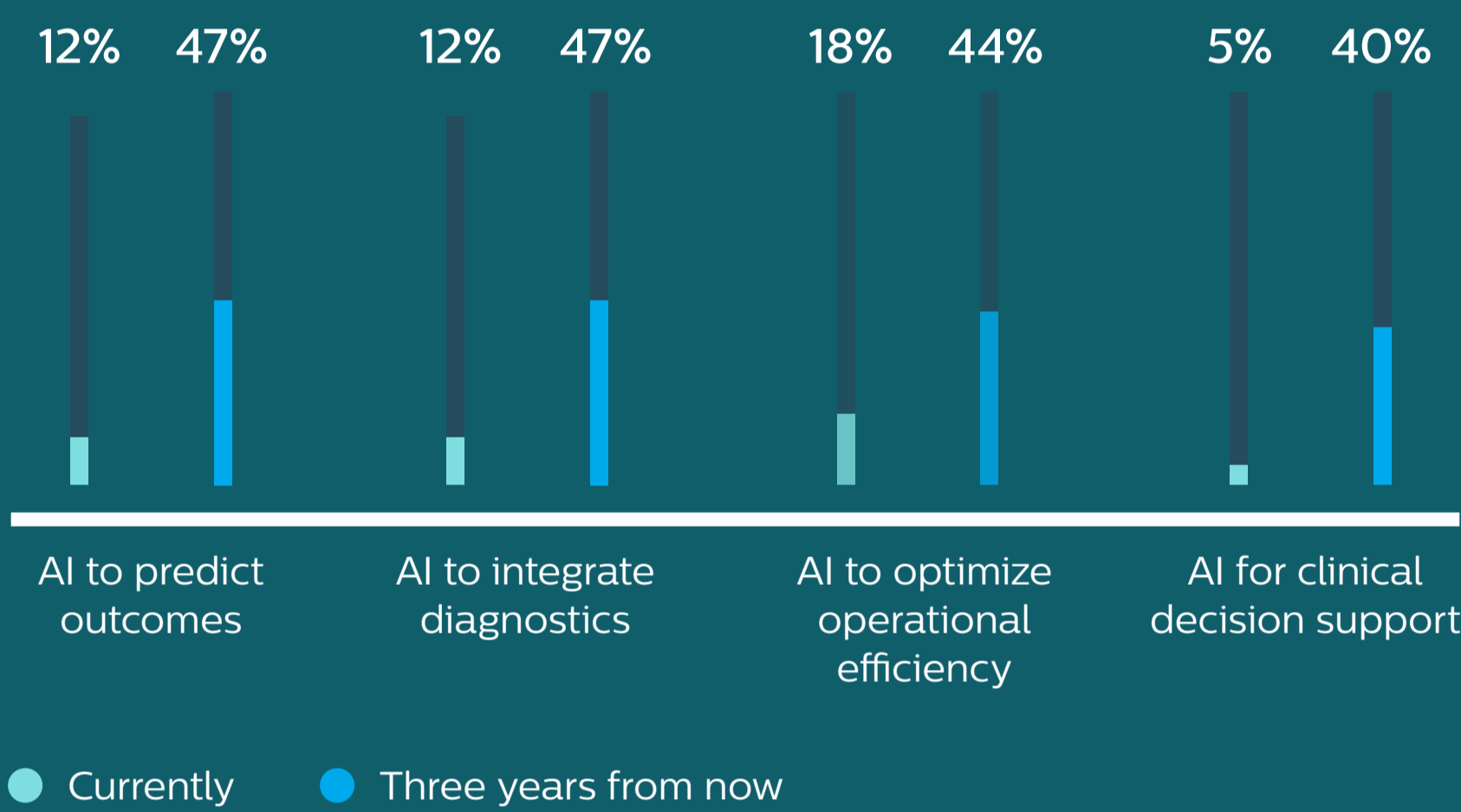
Saudi Arabia highlights

Healthcare leaders in Saudi Arabia identify three key trends that are shaping the future of healthcare

1 In three years, Saudi Arabian healthcare leaders expect about one-fourth of routine care to be delivered beyond hospital walls.



2 Saudi Arabian healthcare leaders see AI emerging as a key investment priority to help them prepare for the future of care.



3 For Saudi Arabian healthcare leaders, implementing sustainability practices within their hospital or healthcare facility will be a top priority in the future

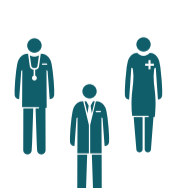
